Sabi Sand is on the migration route of numerous prey species, including the Cape hunting dog (or 'painted wolf'), leopard and lion. Over the years, this pristine reserve has evolved from a hunting ground to an exclusive reserve, teeming with game, where all species of animals, large and small are

protected. While relaxing on the veranda of the main house, guests often can watch elephant and buffalo at the nearby waterhole.

NEED *to know*

Items to remember to bring for your safari to South Africa

- October - April: Casual summer clothes (shorts and cool shirts) and a warm jersey/sweater for the cooler morning and evening temperatures
- May - September: Casual light clothing and a very warm parka/jacket for the very cold mornings and nights
- Cotton clothing in neutral colours is recommended for game drives and compulsory for walks. Keep whites to a minimum, as white attracts certain bugs at night
- Comfortable walking shoes, track shoes or boots for bush walks and sandals to wear at meals and within the lodge area
- Formal attire is not required
- Swimming costumes/bathing suits
- Sun block/sun hat/sunglasses/lip balm
- Cameras, binoculars and spare memory cards
- Video camera and a spare battery

Geography and location

Singita Castleton Camp is situated on 18 000 hectares (44 000 acres) of privately owned land in the Sabi Sand Game Reserve on the western border of the Kruger National Park, Mpumalanga province, South Africa.
