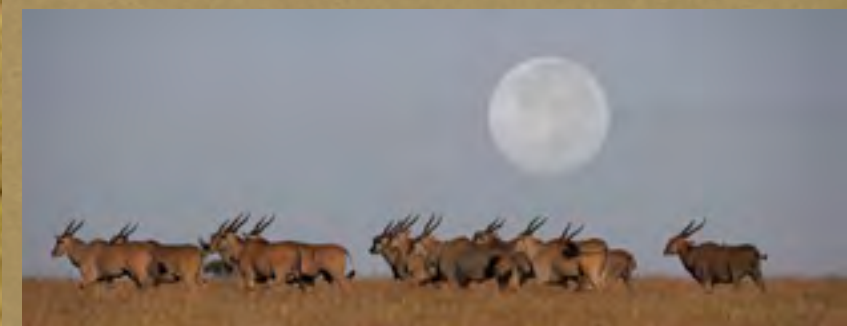

need to know

Items to remember to bring for your safari to Tanzania

- October - April: Casual summer clothes (shorts and cool shirts) and a warm jersey/sweater for the cooler morning and evening temperatures
- May - September: Casual light clothing and a warm parka/jacket for the cool mornings and nights
- Cotton clothing in neutral colours is recommended for game drives and compulsory for walks. Keep whites to a minimum, as white attracts certain bugs at night
- Comfortable walking shoes, track shoes or boots for bush walks and sandals to wear at meals and within the camp area
- Formal attire is not required
- Swimming costumes/bathing suits
- Sun block/sun hat/sunglasses/lip balm
- Camera and spare memory cards
- Video camera and a spare battery

Geography and location

Singita Explore is a completely exclusive mobile camp with access to 340,000 acres of private land in the Serengeti.

Activities

- Private game drives with professional guides
- Archery, star-gazing safaris and horseback safaris. Mountain biking is available at Sasakwa Lodge.
- There are swimming pools at Sabora Tented Camp, Sasakwa Lodge and Faru Faru Lodge
- There are tennis courts at Sabora Tented Camp and Sasakwa Lodge with a choice of surfaces
- There are limited spa treatments available. Alternatively full spa & gym facilities are available at Sabora Tented Camp, Sasakwa Lodge and Faru Faru Lodge
- Singita Shop at Sabora Tented Camp, Sasakwa Lodge and Faru Faru Lodge

Getting there

- Daily scheduled flights are available from Arusha, Kilimanjaro and Nairobi
- Flying time from Kilimanjaro International Airport is 1.5 hours
- Flying time from Arusha Airport is 1.15 hours
- All flights land at Sasakwa airstrip, located a few minutes from Sasakwa Lodge
- Private charters can be arranged
- Road transfer from Arusha is approximately 9.5 hours

Please ensure you consult your doctor before travelling to East Africa. Yellow Fever inoculations are compulsory when entering East Africa. East Africa is a malarial zone so it is essential to ensure that appropriate prophylactics be taken throughout the year.

Tariffs

Tariffs include:

- Accommodation, breakfast, lunch and dinner daily, teas and coffees
- Two open Land Rover safaris per day accompanied by an experienced guide, mountain biking, walking, and archery
- Laundry and valet services
- All drinks, including premium wines, spirits and liqueurs (excluding vintage champagne and vintage wines on the connoisseurs wine list)

Tariffs exclude:

- Government of Tanzania Wildlife Fees of US\$50 per person per night
- Purchases from the Singita Shop
- Air transfers to and from Singita Grumeti Reserves
- Spa treatments
- Certain special meal requests
