Like the Lebombo Euphorbia tree, the design of Lebombo Lodge is one of a kind. Sweeping wooden decks provide perfect vantage points and large sunbeds with snow-white cushions add to the contrast of a place where contemporary style and ancient

wilderness meet. Each of the fifteen suites comprises glass, wood, steel and sleek finishes. The romantic interior beds are set upon rustic wooden flooring and are dressed with soft Egyptian cotton bedding, silky-soft throws and a layered lattice ceiling.

NEED *to know*

Items to remember to bring for your safari to South Africa

- October - April: Casual summer clothes (shorts and cool shirts) and a warm jersey/sweater for the cooler morning and evening temperatures
- May - September: Casual light clothing and a very warm parka/jacket for the very cold mornings and nights
- Cotton clothing in neutral colours is recommended for game drives and compulsory for walks. Keep whites to a minimum, as white attracts certain bugs at night
- Comfortable walking shoes, track shoes or boots for bush walks and sandals to wear at meals and within the lodge area
- Formal attire is not required
- Swimming costumes/bathing suits
- Sun block/sun hat/sunglasses/lip balm
- Cameras, binoculars and spare memory cards
- Video camera and a spare battery

Geography and location

Singita Lebombo Lodge is situated on a 15 000 hectares (33 000 acres) private concession in the eastern south central part of the Kruger National Park, Mpumalanga province, South Africa.
