One of Africa's best-kept secrets, Singita Pamushana Lodge is found within the Malilangwe Wildlife Reserve in south eastern Zimbabwe. Malilangwe Wildlife Reserve is set on 130 000 acres of wilderness in the southern corner of Zimbabwe, bordering the Gonarezhou

National Park. It occupies a key position in an area that is potentially one of Africa's largest bio-refuges and is home to the highest concentration of black rhino in Africa, as well as fourteen species of eagle.

Pamushana Lodge offers indoor and outdoor dining rooms, three lounges, a wine cellar, two heated swimming pools and Jacuzzis overlooking the Malilanagwe Lake and sandstone hills. Pamushana also has a bush spa offering a range of specialised treatments.

Malilangwe Wildlife Reserve is teeming with an astonishing abundance of wildlife, including rare and endangered species. The rare Roan antelope, sable and the Cape hunting dog are seen regularly.

NEED *to know*

Items to remember to bring for your safari to Zimbabwe

- September - April: Casual summer clothes (shorts and cool shirts) and a warm jersey/sweater for the cooler morning and evening temperatures
- May - August: Casual light clothing and a very warm parka/jacket for the very cold mornings and nights
- Cotton clothing in neutral colours is recommended for game drives and compulsory for walks. Keep whites to a minimum, as white attracts certain bugs at night
- Comfortable walking shoes, track shoes or boots for bush walks and sandals to wear at meals and within the lodge area
- Formal attire is not required
- Swimming costumes/bathing suits
- Sun block/sun hat/sunglasses/lip balm
- Camera and spare memory cards
- Video camera and a spare battery

Geography and location

Singita Pamushana Lodge is found within the Malilangwe Wildlife Reserve in south-eastern Zimbabwe and is set within a remote wilderness area that is bounded in the west by the rich riparian woodland flanking the Chiredzi River, which flows into the larger Runde River in the south-west of the property. To the south-east is Gonarezhou ('place of the elephants') National Park and Mozambique's Banyini and Zinave Parks.

Getting there

- Twice-weekly return flight to Buffalo Range Airport from Johannesburg's OR Tambo International Airport on Mondays and Thursdays respectively
- All flights land at Buffalo Range, located 45 minutes from Pamushana Lodge
- Private charters can be arranged

Electricity

Converters are available at each lodge.

Health requirements

Singita Pamushana Lodge is in a malarial zone so it is essential to ensure that appropriate prophylactics be taken throughout the year. Please ensure you consult your doctor before travelling.

Tariffs

Tariffs include:

- Luxurious all-suite accommodation, breakfast, lunch and dinner daily, teas and coffees
- Two open Land Cruiser safaris per day accompanied by an experienced guide
- Laundry and valet services
- Road transfers to and from Buffalo Range Airport
- All drinks, including premium wines, spirits and liqueurs (excluding Champagne)

- Air/road transfers to and from the lodge and Harare
- Spa treatments
- Use of private Land Cruiser
- Certain special meal requests
